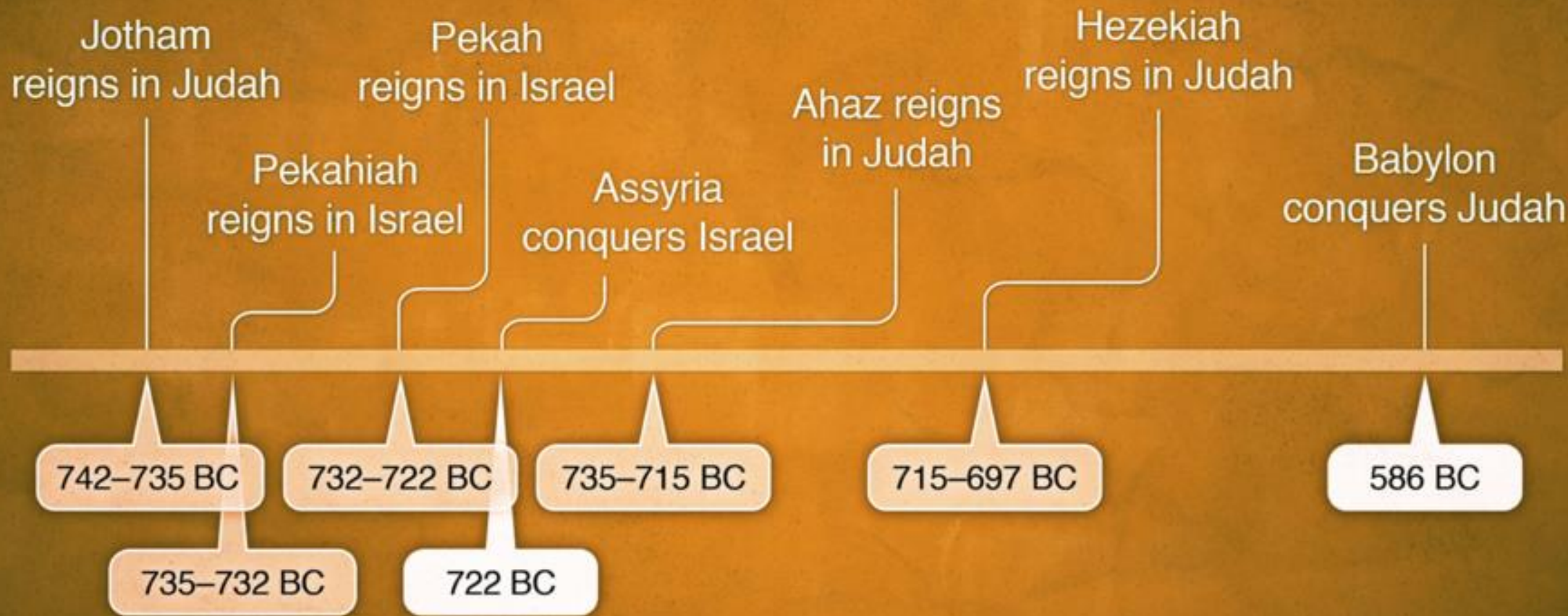

What We Desire – Micah 6:6-7

MICAH

1. Access – *what shall I come before the LORD?*
2. Acknowledgement – *and bow myself before God on high*
3. Value – *shall I come before him with burnt offerings?*
4. Favor – *with calves a year old?*
5. Acceptance, Validation – *will the LORD be pleased?*
6. Pardon, Atonement – *shall I give my firstborn for my transgression?*
7. Absolution – *the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?*

1. Recognition of Authority – *He has told you...what is good.*
2. Submission to Sovereignty – *what does the LORD require of you*
3. Righteous Conformity – *to do justice and love kindness*
4. Continual Humility – *walk humbly with your God*
