

4. Favor – with calves a year old?

5.Acceptance, Validation – *will the LORD be pleased?* 

6.Pardon, Atonement – shall I give my firstborn for my transgression?

7.Absolution – the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?

Righteous Conformity – to do justice and love kindness
