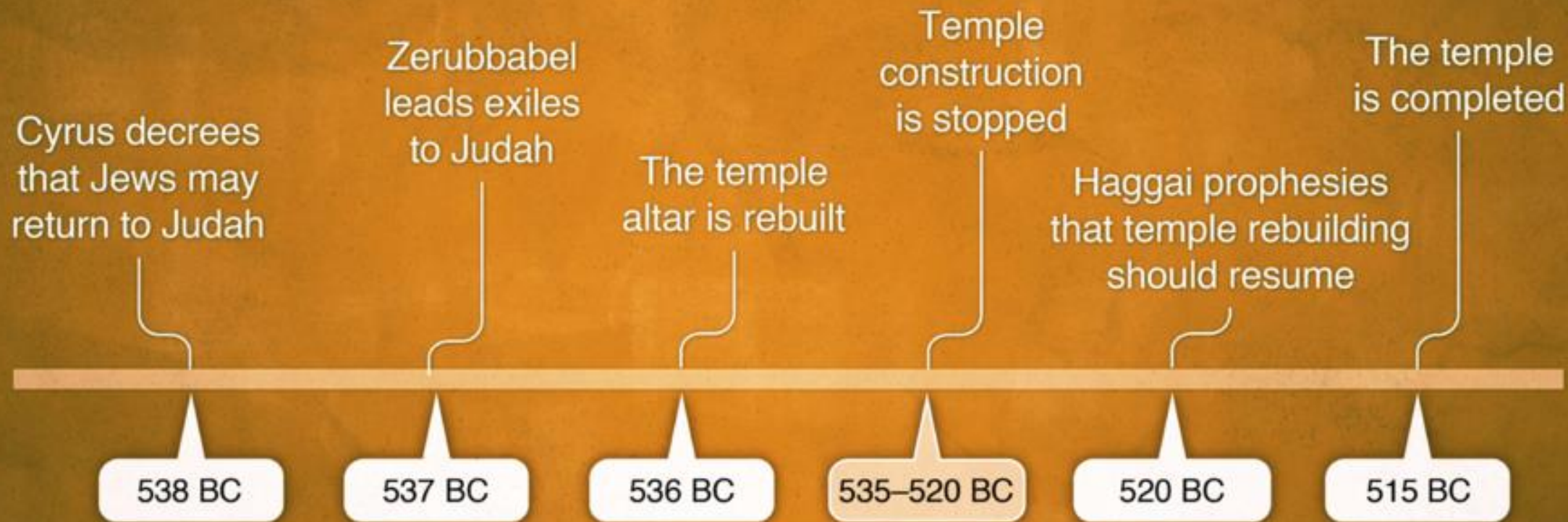

5. Fifth Message: Prophecy Concerning Zerubbabel (2:20–23)
